

Pride for GTU: Anand Pharmacy College (APC), Anand bags the Gandhian Young Technological Innovation Award-2014



It is a moment of great pride for Anand Pharmacy College (APC), Anand, to be amongst **13 awardees** of the Gandhian Young Technological Innovation Award 2014 by Society for Research and Initiatives for Sustainable Technology and Institutions (SRISTI) across India. Anand Pharmacy college was the sole institute of Gujarat amongst the list of awardees, which included 1,400 nominations from 23 Indian states, of which 13 awards were given in the main categories while 27 others got an appreciation from 313 Technology and Scientific Institutions. The applications for the awards were screened by 150 jury members from 60 universities, an MNC and a Research and Development laboratory, across India and abroad.

The awards were given away by Dr. R. A. Mashelkar, former director general of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and SRISTI Founder Prof Anil Gupta. The research team of innovative project included Ms. Parita Moradiya, Dr. Vaishali T. Thakkar and Dr. Nirav V. Patel, who were guided by Dr. Tejal R. Gandhi.
