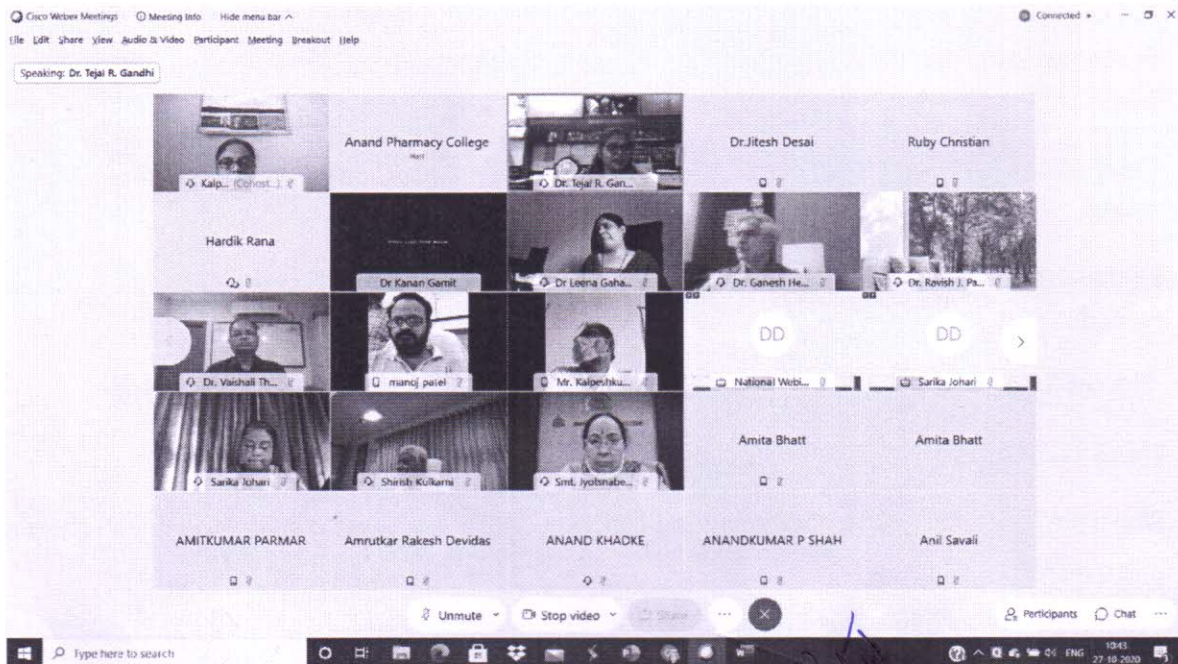

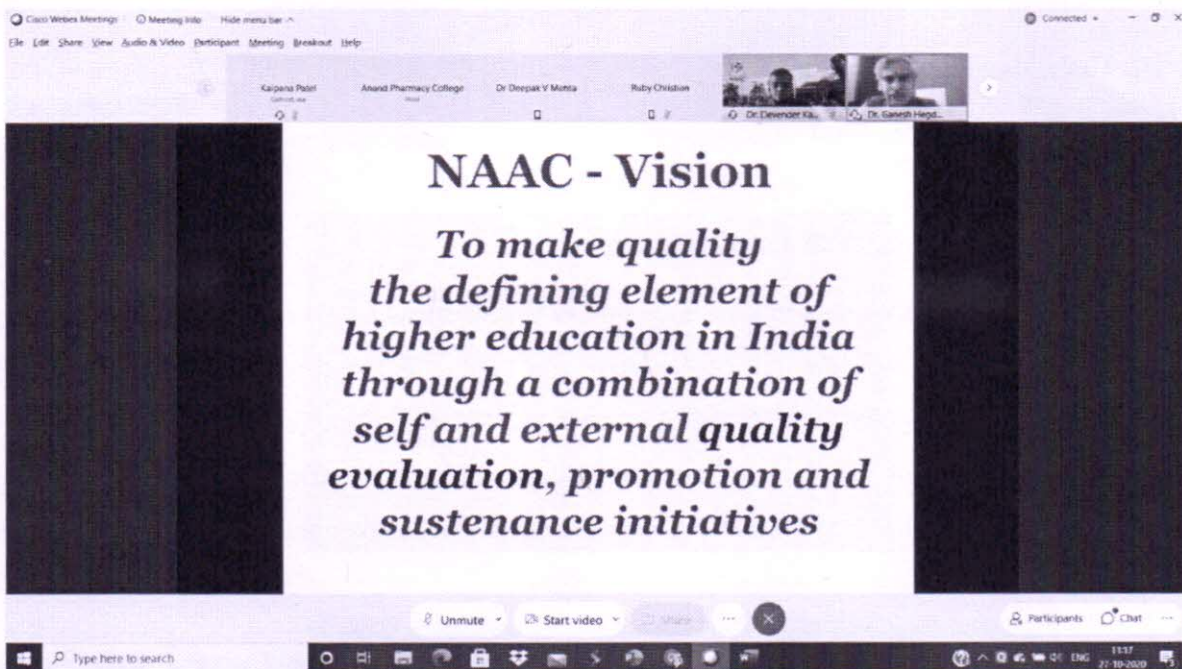
SESSION 1

Title of talk: NAAC: Preparation IIQA and submission of Self Study Report

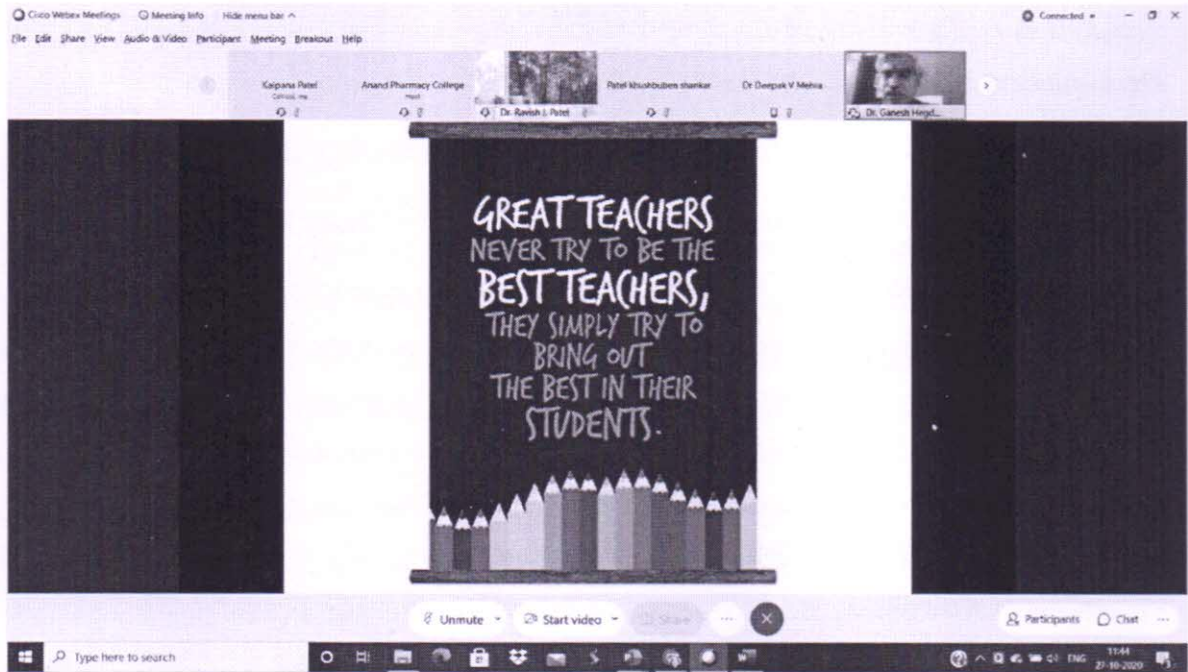

Dr. Devender Kawday

(Deputy Adviser, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore, Karnataka)

Title of talk: Data Validation and Verification Process

Dr. Devender Kawday in his talk focused on DVV process as an exercise to verify data given by HEI in template and data will be ensured from various external web sources like AISHE, NIRF, UGC, institutional website using metrics such as annual report, audited statements of accounts and inflibnet. He also explained how the Quantitative metrics is complemented from the data, metric inputs and supporting documents and whenever there is deviation in data, clarification process can be requested by the institute.

He also discussed about the duration required for DVV process and explained that all deviations and analysis report with clarification will be updated in SSR. He explained the importance of hyperlink, data template filling geotagged photos and English translated documents with proper metrics certified by HOI.

- After analyses of Metrics as per SOP, clarification is sought from HEI, if any.

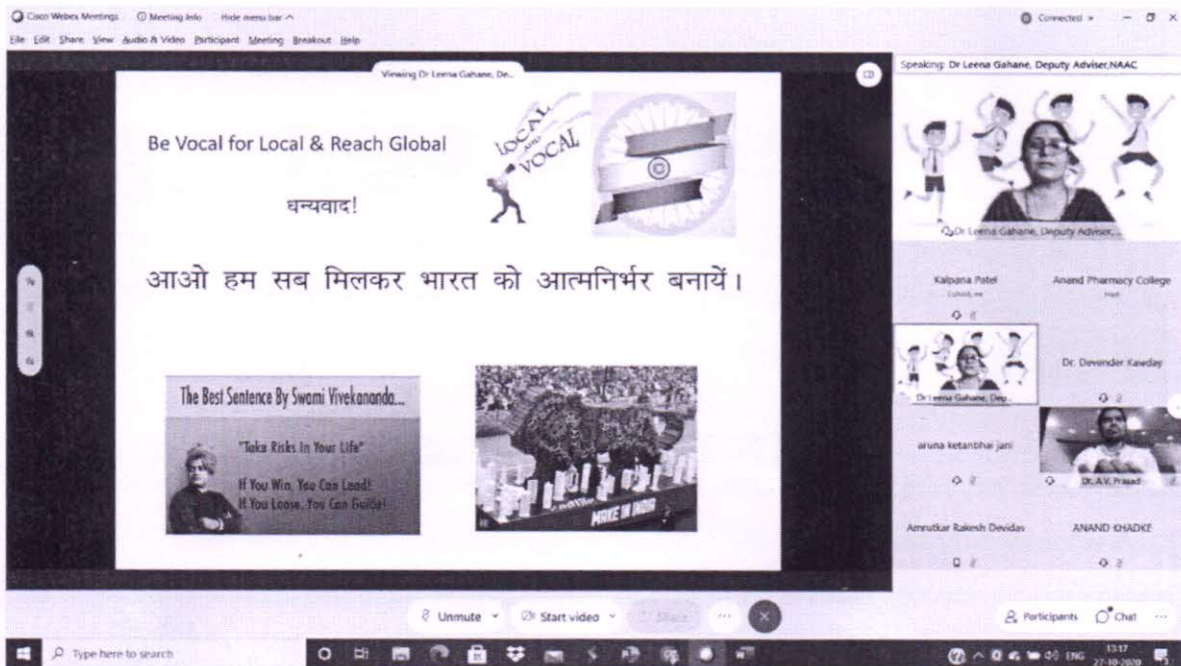
SESSION 3

(Deputy Adviser, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore, Karnataka)

Title of talk: Student Satisfaction Survey

Dr. Leena Gahane, focused various keypoints related to Student satisfaction survey and emphasized that since 2017 survey analysis score is the key component for accreditation. She emphasized about SSS survey introduced since 2017 being an integral component in teaching learning process which falls under Criterion II, key indicator 2.7 and QnM metrics 2.7.1 and to be submitted in Excel template during SSR submission. 50% data should be strictly uploaded and explained that if even short of one student the score will be zero. She provided understanding in her talk that maximum two survey attempts can be initiated and the survey is an analysis of over all approach of the teacher and institution with students judging motivation, interpersonal relationship and feedback.



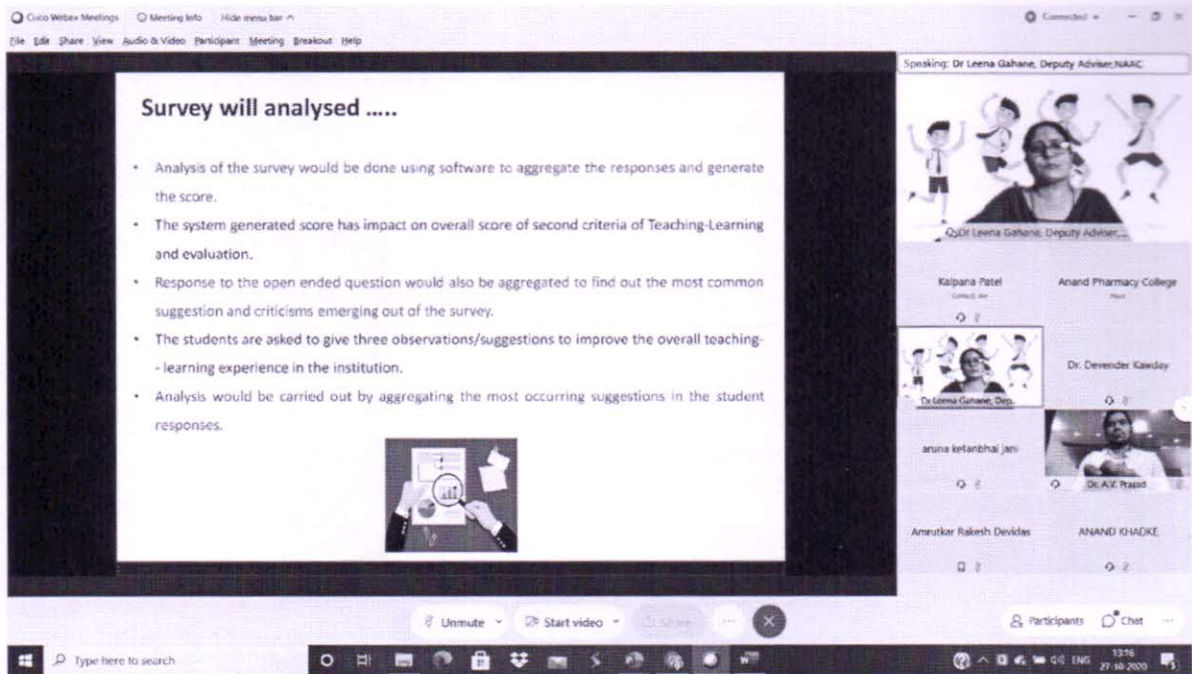

Title of talk: Onsite Peer Team Visit and Assessment Outcome

Prasad provided an indepth understanding of assessment of the the qualitative aspects of SSR, the significance and impact of academics and administrative procedure, and Peer team visit to assess various quality aspects of the institution, SWOC analysis and suggest improving Quality in academic and administrative procedure. The procedure of assessment in these two days Peer team visit was explained alongwith how the outcome is documented in the grade sheet and if the outcome is not satisfactory, then within 30 days the institution can appeal.
