Specific Facilities for Women

Safety & Security:

The institute has taken the following safety & security measures

- ✚ Constitutional committees like Anti-ragging committee, Sexual harassment committee, Gender discrimination Committee and Grievance Redressal Committees have been constituted as per the university guidelines and are functioning successfully.
- ✚ These committees help female employee or students to address any relevant concerns faced by them in the campus without any shame or threat.

- ✚ Institute has installed CCTV Cameras at different locations such as Institute Entrance, Library, Principal's Office, Parking, all corridors and Computer Centre.

- ✚ Girl's common room is equipped with essential facilities like first aid box, bed, wash basin etc.
- ✚ In the construction undertaken by the institute previous year, catering the needs of the female students, more no. of lockers has been installed in girl's room. Also the no. of washrooms have been increased.
- ✚ Sanitary pad vending machine has also been installed in the girl's room for the ease of access.

Girl's hostel

Female safety is of prime concern for the parents. Guardians show a level of trust in institute by sending their ward off for the education. Keeping this in mind the institute right from its inception had constructed Girl's hostel facility adjacent to the institute, thus waving of safety concerns of the parents. Also, the hostel is under CCTV surveillance. The campus is 24*7

guarded by security guards stationed across the campus. Thus creating safe and enjoyable environment for the female students.

New upgraded hostel facility has also been constructed for the females, within the campus itself which is equipped with all the essential facilities.

Scholarship

Currently there are more women than men attending college. The institute provides them with the opportunity of gaining the scholarship based on their merit as well as economic status. These scholarships are funded by either the institute, trust or alumni association.

Women's health



- ca Women are different than men
- ca Many general health texts relay information from studies based on male standards
- ca Besides the physiological concepts, areas such as mental, emotional, and spiritual dimensions of women need to be addressed.
- ca Women health issues are also important!

Women's health key facts



- ca Worldwide, women live an average four years longer than men
- ca In 2011, women's life expectancy at birth was more than 90 years in 46 countries, but only 58 years in the WHO African region
- ca Girls are far more likely than boys to suffer sexual abuse
- ca Road traffic injuries are leading cause of death among adolescent girls in high- and upper-middle-income countries
- ca Almost all 99% of the approximate 287,000 maternal deaths every year occur in developing countries
- ca Globally, cardiovascular disease, often thought to be a "male" problem is the number one killer of the women
- ca Breast cancer is the leading cancer killer among women aged 20-59 years worldwide

Maternal health



- ca Maternal deaths are the second biggest killer of women of reproductive age
- ca Every year, approximately 287,000 women die due to complications in pregnancy & childbirth, 99% of them are in developing countries
- ca Despite the increase in contraceptive use over the past 50 years, many women in all regions still do not have access to modern contraceptive methods
- ca For example, in sub-Saharan Africa, one in four women who wish to delay or stop childbearing does not use any family planning method

ca Tuberculosis:

- Linked to HIV
- Five leading causes of death
- Age = 20-59

ca Injuries:

- Fire - related injuries
- Self-inflicted injuries
- Road injuries
- Burns are Top 10 leading

ca Cervical cancer :

- Second most common of cancer
- 90% deaths occur in low & middle income countries

ca Violence:

- 35% of women worldwide have experienced either intimate partner violence or non-partner sexual violence in their lifetime



Facts



- ca Around the world, one in three girls face inadequate sanitation & many others face social & cultural limits during their periods.
- ca According to Cleveland clinic, Ohio that up to 50% of women will experience some form of digestive distress during their periods.
- ca Menstruation makes the need for safe water, sanitation & hygiene, especially important for women.

Cont..



- ca According to a report published by Water Aid, illnesses related to a lack of water, basic sanitation and hygiene were responsible for the deaths of almost 800,000 women around the world in a single year making it the fifth biggest killer of women behind heart disease, stroke, lower respiratory infections and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.
