# Save water

- Instead of cups, bring reusable water bottle to reduce the waste of water needed to wash it.
- Use Leftover water from drinking glass to water plants
- Report any kind of leaks to admin department in order to save water.
- Install low flow toilet or dual flush on your existing toilet.
- Turn off Fauset after using, also check before leaving labs or other premises of the college
- Do not drench plants or garden during peak periods
- Install irrigation system
- Arranged various activities regarding water conservation to increase awareness
- Fix leaky taps, toilets, sprinklers and appliances as soon as possible.
- To water a plant instead of pipes, sprinklers can be used.
- Rain water harvesting plan can be used to store rain water and for irrigation purpose.

# Electricity Usage

- Regardless of the time of day, turn off the lights in any empty rooms.
- Make use of energy-saving LED lights.
- Unplug unused devices and appliance

- Make use of natural sunlight and ventilation if possible.

# Campus Parking

- Provide prominent signs that makes it crystal clear where to park for students and faculty members who are new to campus.
- Provide backup plans, such as a parking hotline or an app.
- There should be a designated parking area for disabled people.
- Create a welcoming parking slogan: *You do belong here. And so will your car.*
- To reduce fuel usage and traffic, only use vehicle when it necessary within the campus
- Maintain a separate garbage disposal system for plastic waste.
- For each college, a separate watchman must be appointed to oversee the parking zone.
- For the security reason, installed CCTV cameras in the campus parking.
- Separate parking facilities should be provided for heavy vehicle and two wheelers.

# Plastic usage

- For the canteen and college events, choose reusables.
- Encourage students for less plastic usage in packed lunches.
- Use biodegradable plates, cups, spoon in the canteen instead of plastic.
- Maintain a separate garbage disposal system for plastic waste.
- Stop buying bottled water and chewing gum
- For laboratory plastic waste maintain separate garbage disposal system
- Instead of throwing away plastic products, consider repurposing them and purchasing recyclable materials.
