BoS Pcol 2.1: Passing of Minutes of the Last Meeting

Discussion:

The institute have applied for two new programmes (M. Pharm Pharmaceutical Analysis and Pharm D (PB)) to PCI. Addendum to Academic regulations for M. Pharm (Pharmaceutical Analysis) and Academic regulations for Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate) were presented for review. Further these regulations align with PCI requirements and NEP-2020.

Resolution:

The Addendum to Academic regulations for M. Pharm (Pharmaceutical Analysis) and academic regulations for Pharm D (PB) was approved without modifications, subject to final approval to run the programme from PCI.

BoS Pcol 2.3: Review and approval of academic calendar (2025-26)

Discussion:

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The academic calendar for the academic year 2025-26 session was presented for discussion. It was carefully reviewed to ensure a well-structured schedule for academic sessions, examinations. Dr. Tejal Gandhi asked to reconfirm the total working days (200) for Pharm D 2nd year.

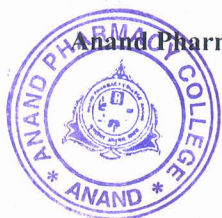

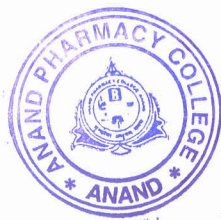

No additional matters were raised by the members.

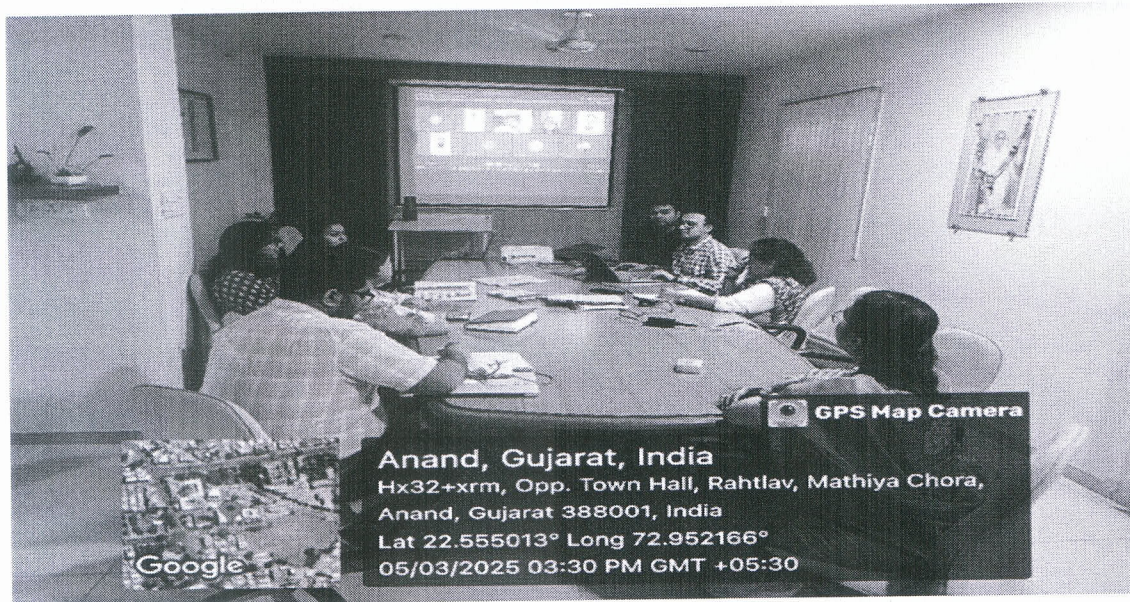
Resolution:
