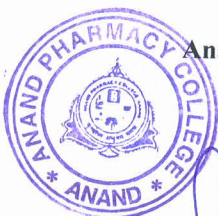
#### 2.2.1 Addendum to Academic Regulations of M. Pharm (Pharmaceutical Analysis)

#### 2.2.2 Academic Regulations of Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate)

**Proceedings:** It was informed to all members that the institute have proposed two new programs, M. Pharm, Pharmaceutical Analysis and Pharm D (PB) for approval to PCI. The addendum included course of study for M. Pharm (Pharmaceutical Analysis). Moreover, the new academic regulations for Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate) prepared and approved by Board of Studies members was presented for review and comment. These regulations aligned with the PCI requirements and NEP-2020.

**Highlights of Proceedings:** During the meeting, Dr. M. N. Saraf suggested the inclusion of a course on Artificial Intelligence in Pharmaceutical Sciences to align with emerging industry trends. In response, Dr. Tejal Gandhi informed the council about the recent inclusion of a certification course on Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning. Dr. Ajay Khopade emphasized the importance of introducing Research Pedagogy at an early stage in the curriculum and also proposed the addition of a dedicated course on Intellectual Property. Additionally, Dr. Tejal Gandhi highlighted that Research methodology and Biostatistics course is included as a core subject in 8<sup>th</sup> semester B. Pharm. She also emphasized that the submission of PSAR reports is already a regular practice followed by M. Pharm students and IPR related topics were already covered in Research methodology and specialization subjects in M. Pharm. Dr. N. R. Sheth recommended that the existing 150-hour Practice School be made compulsory, based on student preferences and academic flexibility. Further, Dr. Tejal Gandhi explained that the practice school norms as per Gujarat Technological University were followed which included the training in medical store, industry, hospital based on student's interest.

**Resolution:** The council approved the addendum to Academic Regulations of M. Pharm (Pharmaceutical Analysis) and new academic regulations of Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate), without any modification.

Pharm across all specializations, the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Pharm D program, the 1<sup>st</sup> year of Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate), and the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters of M. Pharm in Pharmaceutical Analysis. She also informed that the syllabus prescribed by PCI has been adopted for various subjects with three minor changes. First change is assigning weightage to subtopics in each chapter for smooth teaching and question paper drawing by faculty and examiner respectively. Second change is inclusion of additional practical's in practical course in addition to specified by PCI. Third change was inclusion of new subtopics related to recent trends in some chapters of some courses in syllabus of PCI. Updates was also given to all members related to SEC, VAC, and MDS courses where syllabus

was designed meticulously by faculty members followed by identification of subject expert for seeking their suggestions to enrich the syllabus, further the syllabus was finalized with inputs of the subject experts .

**Highlights of Proceedings:** Dr. M. N. Saraf suggested the inclusion of Industrial Visits as an essential component of the curriculum to enhance practical exposure. He also suggested for the implementation of industry-defined projects. Dr. Tejal informed about the routine practice of the institution that included mid-term evaluations conducted by industry experts to ensure alignment with real-world expectations. Further, he appreciated IIP cell activities and emphasized that collaboration can be strengthened to facilitate industry-sponsored projects, support technology transfer initiatives, and promote revenue generation. Dr. Kalpana also informed that more than 20 students of various PG courses every year take up industry defined projects.

**Resolution:** The syllabus and course outcomes for various programs, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters of B. Pharm and M. Pharm across all specializations, the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Pharm D program, the 1<sup>st</sup> year of Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate), and the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters of M. Pharm in Pharmaceutical Analysis were approved without any modification.

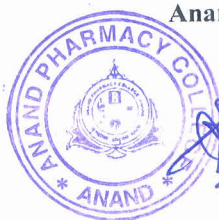

**Proceedings:** A timeline for the timely declaration of results was also deliberated. Member secretary presented that the results for first semester B. Pharm and M. Pharm (all specializations) were declared on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025. She informed that the results compilation was completed via ERP software and results declaration was slightly delayed due to various issues faced in new ERP software during compilation of external results first time.

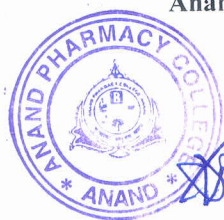
**2.10.3. For review and approval: Student Development scheme**

**Proceedings:** Dr. Kalpana informed to all council members that the student development norms were in practice in the institution since 2007 which was subsequently revised in 2012, 2013, 2016 and 2020. To this 2020 student development scheme, new additions were Addendum I and II. Addendum I as Travel Support Scheme for participation in Hackathon, Boot Camp, Startup Summit, Expos, Innovation/Entrepreneurship-related training and Competition, and SDG Challenges were presented as students were participating in majority of innovation related events. Addendum II - Norms for felicitation of student Innovation and Entrepreneurship award were also presented for motivation to achiever students.

**Resolution:** The council approved and recommended the Addendum I and Addendum II to the student development scheme norms for presentation to the governing body.

**2.10.4. For review and approval: New Course Code for Skill Enhancement Course**

**Proceedings:** Skill enhancement course was already approved as an elective course in teaching scheme in previous meeting. Members of four different departments were involved in designing of four different syllabus for elective course which were approved by the Board of Studies. Four departments namely, Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance department offered elective named Essential Skills for Quality Assurance (M000305EP), Pharmaceutics department offered elective named Fundamental Techniques for the manufacturing of Oral Solid dosage forms (M000306EP), Pharmacology department offered elective named Fundamental Techniques for Preclinical Research (M000307EP), Regulatory affairs department offered elective named Essential Skills for Regulatory Affairs (M000308EP). From these four electives offered by different departments as skill enhancement course, student of each specialization needs to select one elective except the elective offered by their department to broaden learning opportunities. These new course codes for M. Pharm Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) approved by Board of Studies were presented for review and approval for inclusion into the regular teaching scheme.
